KENNEBEC WILDERNESS TRAILS

Overview

Located on a 156-acre tract of public parkland owned by the Township of Central Frontenac, the Kennebec Wilderness Trails offer four seasons of outdoor recreational activity; hiking, geo-caching, birding, snow- shoeing. The trail network consists of over 7 kilometers of hiking trails winding through a mixed forest of deciduous and coniferous trees. The valley meadows, wooded hillsides and rocky ridges are home to an abundance of wildlife. The terrain is rugged and undulating in many areas, offering a challenging hike for all ages. The trails can be accessed at Trailheads located at 28786 Highway # 7 and on Nordic Road in the Kennebec Shores Waterfront Community.
